### Riga

### I General questions

- 1. These Regulations prescribe the procedure for the Latvian Open Climbing Championship,
- "Lead Games 2020" (hereinafter referred to as the Competition).
- 2. Competition is organized with the aim to promote sport climbing in Latvia.
- 3. The goal of the Competition is to identify the strongest athletes in the sport climbing discipline in year 2020.
- 4. Competition is organized by Traverss Climbing Club and Latvian Mountaineering Association.
- 5. Chief referee of the Competition is Vladimir Stepanov.
- 6. Responsible for routes is Sergey Nurmamatov (Russia).

## II Place and time of the Competition

- 1. The Competition is held at the TSI Sports Center, Lomonosova Street 1 k-3, Riga.
- 2. Date: February 7-8, 2020.
- 3. The Competition regulations and race information are published on the websites http://traverss.lv and www.climbing.lv (old version).

### **III Competitors and rules**

- 1. The Competition is open for all athletes born in 2008 or earlier.
- 2. Athletes from Latvia born in 2004 or earlier (Group A) earns ranking points in Sport Climbing Discipline.

- 3. Competitors must have their own equipment for Sport Climbing for lead rope belaying (belts, safety equipment and rope minimum of 30 meters).
- 4. Additional information about the Competition can be received by phone +37129129834 or e-mail: info@traverss.lv.
- 5. Each adult competitor is personally responsible for his / her state of health in the Competition.
- 6. Persons who represents participants up to 18 years old have to submit a written application with Name, Surname, year of birth of the competitors, as well as confirmation of the athlete's preparedness for the Competition and health status of an underage athlete on the compliance of Cabinet of Ministers Regulation No. 594 (06.09.2016) "Sportistu un bērnu ar paaugstinātu fizisko slodzi veselības aprūpes un medicīniskās uzraudzības kārtība"
- 7. The Organizer shall comply with the requirements of the Personal Data Processing Law.
- 8. Costs related to the travel, accommodation, meals or other expenses of the competitors and their accompanying persons should be covered by the competitor or his / her representative organization (club, association).

## IV. Registration of participants and entry fee

- 1. Registration of participants for the Competition http://traverss.lv
- 1.1. The participant completes the registration for the Competition once he has paid the entry fee.
- 1.2. The entry fee have to be paid before the start of each group.

- 2.2. Registration from 01.02.2020 until 05.02.2020 inclusive 25.00 EUR, payment by bank transfer;
- 2.3. Registration for the Competition starting from 06.02.2020 or on the day and place of the Competition -30.00 EUR, cash payment.

### VI Competition rules

- 1. Will be offered 25-30 routes (difficulty level 5c 8a) for athletes during the Qualification.
- 2. Points will be assigned only for finished routes. The number of points for each route depends on the difficulty of the route and its on-sight, red-point or zone reach.
- 3. The results includes the 8 routes climbed by the athlete, which are scored with the highest score.
- 4. The Top 6 athletes will be participating in the FINAL, judging separately for men and women group.
- 5. If there will not be at least 4 Latvian athletes (Group A) among the 6 athletes who qualify for the FINAL, the number of finalists will be increased to include 4 Latvian athletes (Group A) in the FINAL.
- 6. Qualification results will be taken into account if there are the same FINAL score for two or more athletes. In case the qualification results are also the same, the climbing time of the FINAL route will be taken into account.
- 7. There will be 1 route for each women and men group in the FINAL, route control time is 8 minutes.
- 8. Athletes from Latvia (Group A) will receive a rating points for the Sport Climbing in Climbing Discipline.

# VII Winners reward ceremony

- 1. Rewarding is only for the participants who take first, second and third place.
- 2. Winners will be awarded with Organizer's diplomas and medals.
- 3. Three best athletes from Latvia (Group A) will be awarded with medals and diplomas for their participation in the Latvian Championship.

### **VIII Protests**

1. Protests can be submitted not later than 30 minutes after the announcement of the results. Protest examination fee is 35 EUR.
